

CONFINED SPACE STANDBY / RESCUE



Working in confined spaces is risky business that requires organizations to have an effective rescue plan. Our confined space Attendant/Entry Supervisor and standby/rescue teams are present to assist with safeguarding the initial entry personnel and trained to take immediate action in an emergency situation.



Rescue Services

We provide confined space Attendant/Entry Supervisor and standby/rescue activities for all entry conditions. These activities and services are tailored to site-specific emergency preparedness needs and include:

- Attendant and Entry Supervisor
- Standby Rescue in Non-IDLH Atmospheres
- Standby Rescue in IDLH Atmospheres

The Attendant/Entry Supervisor and standby/rescue services provided by ACSS meet both OSHA 1910.146, 1926 Subpart AA and NFPA rescue requirements. During these activities, ACSS provides all entry and rescue hardware for our personnel.

Confined Space Services

When lives are on the line and every second counts, ACSS's expertly trained, focused teams are ready to react quickly. To be successful in achieving the objective of rescuing entrants, ACSS teams conduct frequent practice rescue operations at all job-sites. If a confined space rescue is necessary, ACSS personnel will conduct the following activities:

- Enter confined space adhering to OSHA 1910.146 or 1926 Subpart AA
- Complete air quality control activities (including air quality evaluation, ventilation, use of IDLH respirators for both entrants and rescuers)
- Patient packaging and removal of entrants
- Begin EMS care and summon appropriate outside fire/rescue services
